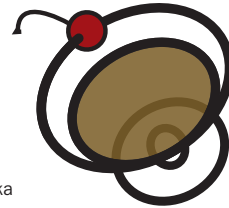

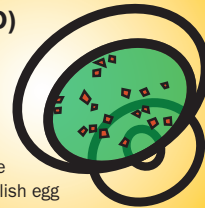
Combine 2 parts Grey Goose Vanilla Vodka and 1 part Starbucks Liqueur. Garnish with a cherry.
